
Hi all,

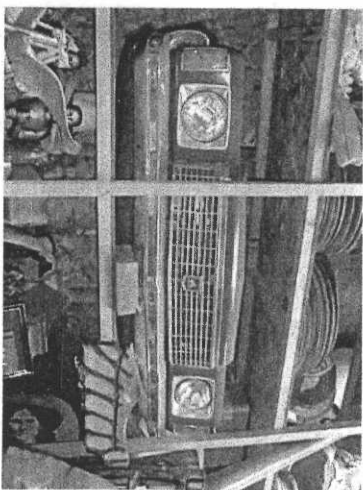
