Happy New Year to you all. I hope you had a nice break.



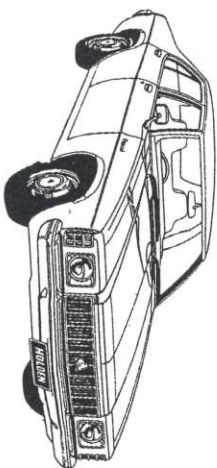
